GLOUCESTER COMMUNITY AWARENESS AND CONCERN GROWING OVER CSG

Over 90 people attended Groundswell Gloucester's presentation and documentary film "Fractured Country" narrated by Jack Thompson, last Wednesday evening. Judging by the turnout from Gloucester residents, there is growing interest in the concerns of many people regarding the issues surrounding the coal seam gas industry.

After the presentation and film there was a Q & A session with a panel made up of the Executive Committee of Groundswell Gloucester who were instrumental in putting together the document, "Exposing the Risks: Fundamental Flaws in AGL's application to frack CSG Wells in Gloucester".
