

Great Lakes Advocate – 8 December 2015: A request for the state government to buy-back AGL's petroleum exploration licence in Gloucester has been unanimously supported by the Mid North Coast Regional Organisations of Councils (MIDROC).

In the lead up to the Minister for Local Government Paul Toole's Fit for the Future announcements, which are expected before Christmas, a scheduled meeting between member MIDROC councils Bellingen, Coffs Harbour, Kempsey, Port Macquarie, Taree, Nambucca and Gloucester was postponed last week but a vote on the matter went ahead regardless.

The buy-back motion put by Gloucester's mayor John Rosenbaum and passed at November's Gloucester Shire Council meeting was supported unanimously by all member councils.
